EXTRA-TERRESTRIAL DISCUSSION GROUP (2026 Term 4)

EXTRA-TERRESTRIAL DISCUSSION GROUP

This course is a companion to the Mysteries of Life (previously called Extra-Terrestrial Contact Past & Present) course held on Friday afternoons. It is based on similar subject matter to the Friday class. Unlike the Friday class, however, the Tuesday class does not have a tightly structured presentation format following a defined subject path. It follows the needs and interests of the class members. Members can nominate topics (in advance) that they would like to cover and they and other class members are invited to contribute by way of presentations (formal or informal although these are not mandatory), stories and discussion points. There are also videos to watch with plenty of time allocated to discussion of the video content matter. The tutor acts as co-ordinator and facilitator for these activities, but it is the class members who drive the course and subject matter.

Subject areas that we explore include stories of extra-terrestrial contact (both past and present), unexplained archaeological mysteries (e.g. pyramids and structures around the world which are hard to explain without the use of advanced technology), ancient civilisations, religion, spirituality, life, consciousness and reality.

MYSTERIES OF LIFE: FROM EXTRA-TERRESTRIALS, ARCHAEOLOGICAL ENIGMAS, ANCIENT GODS, RELIGION, SPIRITUALITY, TO CONSCIOUSNESS AND REALITY (2026 Term 4)

MYSTERIES OF LIFE: FROM EXTRA-TERRESTRIALS, ARCHAEOLOGICAL ENIGMAS, ANCIENT GODS, RELIGION, SPIRITUALITY, TO CONSCIOUSNESS AND REALITY.

This course begins by exploring evidence from around the world indicating that Earth has been visited by advanced extra-terrestrial beings both today and throughout history. We explore modern day sightings of UFOs and stories of encounters with extra-terrestrials, and review what has been happening in the US over the last few years in terms of UFO and ET disclosure.

We also explore significant evidence that our planet's ancient cultures were aided and influenced by mysterious visitors who were eventually regarded as gods. Almost every past culture has stories of visitors from the heavens, who came and taught them culture, agriculture, animal husbandry, astronomy and the construction of buildings and cities. The influence of these visitations has shaped religious beliefs and subsequent societies.

We then explore unexplained archaeological mysteries (e.g. pyramids, structures and artifacts around the world which are hard to explain without the use of advanced technology). Further, we look at ancient civilisations, religion, spirituality, life, consciousness and reality and ponder the age-old questions "What are we and why are we here?"

Course delivery is by formal presentation and group discussion. This one-year course, previously called "Extra-terrestrial Contact: Past & Present", is restarting from the beginning in 2026. 2026 may be the last year that this course runs so if you are interested, think about enrolling.

CALLIGRAPHY: THE ART OF BEAUTIFUL WRITING (2026 Term 4)

CALLIGRAPHY: THE ART OF BEAUTIFUL WRITING

The Art of Beautiful Writing- Gothic (Blackletter), Faux and Commercial.

Have you ever looked at a handwritten, historical document and wondered "Who wrote this? How was it written? Could I do that?" If admiring those documents has captured your imagination and spurred you on to learn how to form letters and numbers beyond what you learned in school, then this course is for you!

In this beginners' course you will learn the basic strokes of Gothic (Blackletter) Calligraphy, and be introduced to Faux Calligraphy (calligraphy done with normal pens) and Commercial Calligraphy (different ways of monetizing your beautiful writing). You will learn the magic of creating letters and numbers in simplified Gothic and Faux Calligraphy using pens, nibs, paintbrushes and inks. In Commercial, you will create outdoor menus and signs.
